Year 6 SATs Tests May 9th to May 14th

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Year 6 SATs week is the week beginning Monday 9th May and there are only 9 school days left until SATs begin. It is imperative that pupils are in school in the weeks leading up to SATs to prepare for the tests, as these tests are important in their positioning at their secondary school.

Due to the importance of these tests, please can we ask that you **only** keep your children at home during this time if they are being physically sick. Coughs, colds, sore throats, tummy ache, headaches can all be treated with calpol before the child comes to school. If pupils are absent without a valid reason, home visits will be made.

Children diagnosed with Covid 19 need to isolate at home in the days up to SATs but the government have stipulated that pupils with Covid can come to school on the days of the SATs test (9th to 12th May) specifically for the test and the test will be administered in a 'Covid Room', where the pupil will not come into close contact with anyone and strict social distancing and hygiene procedures will be followed. If you do find that your child has Covid during this week please contact the school, and we will give timings of when your child will need to be here to sit the tests.

During the week of the SATs test, all year 6 children must be in school to sit their tests. It is important for all children to be here on time every day.

Each year, during test week, we offer a breakfast club to those children in Year 6 taking tests, and this year is no exception.

The breakfast club will be held in the hall and will be available from 9th – 12th May only, starting at 8:00am in the hall. Children will be offered fruit juice, cereal, toast/croissants, butter and jam. There will be no cost to the children for this. **We would like all children to attend** as we feel it really helps the atmosphere and it creates a very supportive environment for the children. Pupils must arrive by 8:50 at the latest to ensure they are registered, settled into their rooms with the correct equipment for the start time of 9:15.
